- Rita Sofía dos Santos Severino, Center for Astrobiology (INTA-CSIC), whose research work focuses on finding universal peptide biomarkers in planetary exploration.
- Isabel Salado Ortega, Doñana Biological Station (EBD- CSIC), whose work is developed in the research field of ecology, evolution and conservation biology.

Monthly Participation in the program "Enfermedades Raras" (Rare Diseases) on Radio Libertad


